

Are you an EU/EEA/SWISS citizen living in the Bailiwick of Guernsey?

How do I apply for settled status?

From 30 March 2019, if you are an EU/EEA/Swiss citizen living in the Bailiwick of Guernsey you can apply for settled status.

The application process is easy. You will need to fill in a short application form and provide some basic information.

1. IDENTITY

You will have to give your personal details and provide a valid passport or national ID card.



2. BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY RESIDENCE

Your details will be checked against your social security data so you will need to provide your Guernsey Social Security Number. You may have to provide supporting documents.



3. CRIMINALITY

You will need to declare criminal convictions in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or any other country.



4. PRE-SETTLED STATUS

You will be granted pre-settled status if you have been living in the Bailiwick of Guernsey for less than 5 years.



5. SETTLED STATUS

You will be granted settled status if you have been living in the Bailiwick of Guernsey for 5 years or more.
